The simple act of reading 20 minutes a day to your child lays the foundation to becoming a fluent reader. Children can understand concepts far beyond their reading skills.

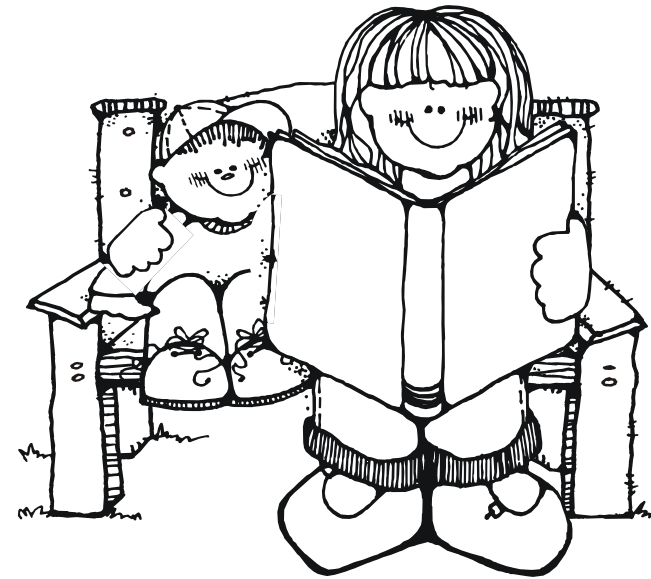
Hearing and being able to talk about stories with an adult will help with comprehension, predicting, and other valuable reading skills.
