

Thank you for signing up for the 2019 Local Author Fair, taking place at the Modesto Library on Saturday, September 21. **Here are a few things you need to know:**



- **Space is first-come, first-served.** Once you check in, you may set up your booth on the 16th street side of the library's portico. The event will run from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- We ask that you bring your own table and chairs for your booth. If you will be unable to provide your own table and chairs, we may be able to provide these if requested at least a week prior to the event, however please note that our tables and chairs are limited. Easels, props, or additional display items may be used as long as they pertain to your published works, are contained to your general booth area, and do not present a tripping hazard.
- Books may be sold on the portico of the library only. You or your associate(s) will be responsible for handling the sale of your books. Library staff will not be able to assist in book sales.
- Only published written works may be sold during the event. Please refrain from using your booth to sell or promote other services.
- Due to health regulations, **NO FOOD** may be given out.
- An event flyer is attached to this packet, which can be printed, copied and shared to help promote the event. You may also visit the Stanislaus County Library's Facebook page to share our post about the 2019 Local Author Fair.

The Local Author Fair is an opportunity for members of the community to meet and support local writers. This event helps heighten public awareness of the local arts culture in a fun and memorable way.
