## Information Sheet

We are excited about your application to participate in our All-Kids Craft Fair on Saturday, October 14<sup>th</sup>. Here are a few things you need to know:

- All items must be made and sold by children 7-14 years old. \*  
Please no crafts made by adults.
- No tickets, calendars, used, or give-away items.
- Remember: due to health regulations, **NO FOOD CRAFTS**. This includes anything made using prepackaged food, candy, or drinks.
- You will need to set up your own "booth." Most kids bring a card table and a couple of folding chairs. We will be outside on the portico, so dress accordingly.
- Please come no earlier than 8:00 a.m. to set up and decorate your booth. Space is first-come, first-serve. Selling will start at 9:00 a.m.
- All craft items must be \$5 or less. Remember, a lot of your customers will be other kids. **TIP:** Crafts priced at \$1 or less sell best!
- Care of your money and giving change to your customers will be up to you, so we suggest you bring a "money box" with you. You might also want to provide small paper bags or plastic baggies for customers.
- Remember to smile and look interested. A friendly face attracts customers!
- We are including a sheet of flyers announcing the craft fair. Please find somewhere in your neighborhood to post them, and feel free to make extra copies if you want to. **THE MORE PEOPLE WHO KNOW ABOUT THE FAIR, THE MORE CUSTOMERS YOU WILL HAVE!**
- Parents & Teens: Check out our Facebook page and repost Craft Fair info! Word of mouth is the best advertisement for this program.

\*This event is intended for individual crafters to learn about pricing, advertising, dealing with customers, handling money, and other aspects of being an entrepreneur (visit the library and look at call number section X745.5 for craft ideas). Family members and a small number of friends may participate together. A responsible adult must accompany the participants and remain present during the craft fair.

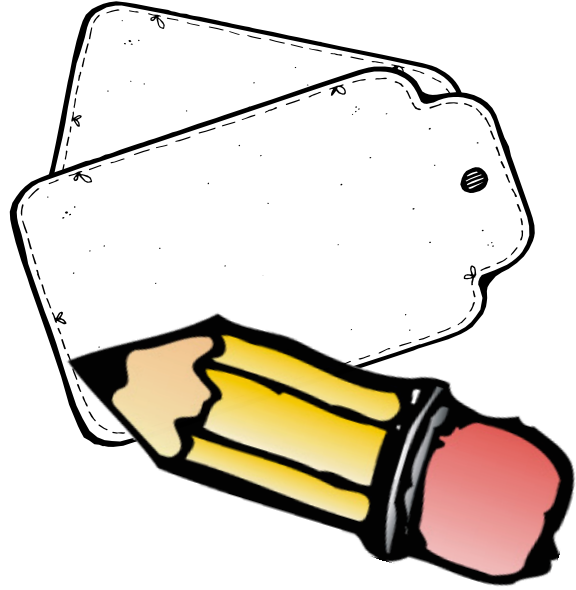
