March Events at the Hughson Library

Children, teens and families are invited to enjoy a variety of free programs at the Hughson Library this March, beginning with two Dr. Seuss themed programs in celebration of the author's birthday. March 1 through 11, children are invited to "Find the Hat" in the library. Those who find the Cat in the Hat's missing hat will win a prize. On Thursday, March 2 at 12 p.m. children can make *One Fish Two Fish Red Fish Blue Fish* themed headbands.

The library will host a LEGO® Day on Wednesday, March 1 at 3 p.m. Children will have the opportunity to build LEGO® creations that will then be displayed in the library. Participants under the age of 4 must have direct parental supervision.

Teens can make fund jars on Tuesday, March 7 at 3:30 p.m. The completed jars can be used to save for college, a trip to Europe, a car, and more. Participants will also learn tips for planning and saving money.

A paper birds craft will take place on Tuesday, March 14 at 3 p.m. Children will learn how to create paper birds out of cupcake liners.

Two seasonal crafts will be offered this month, beginning with the 3-D Rainbow Craft and Rainbow Science program on Wednesday, March 15 at 3 p.m. Children will make 3-D rainbows out of paper, as well as experiment with making a rainbow, using candy. On Wednesday, March 22 at 3 p.m. children can craft pet clouds to take home.

Children can test their skills at the library's indoor miniature golf course on Tuesday, March 28 from 12 to 6 p.m. This nine hole mini golf course is made out of picture books.
