**Librarian's Report: Chris Moreno**

1. Chris reported that Letters of Recognition from Senator Diane Feinstein were received for Pat (Shining Star Award) and Denise (Joan Patterson Stellar Achievement Award).
2. Staff/Library Updates:
  - a. Olga has accepted the position as the Ceres Branch Supervisor.
  - b. Library assistant positions newly filled, and those still in the recruiting phase (including 2 Bilingual LA storytellers) were mentioned.
3. Children's Dept. Update:
  - a. Summer Reading Challenge is underway. Adults can also participate.
  - b. Upcoming events were listed. Among them were:
    - All Teens Craft Fair 6/16
    - #Modesto Rocks! (rock painting) 6/29. The library will provide the paint, and rock donations are needed.

**Membership Report: compiled by Ellen Dambrosio**

1. Currently we have 79 paid 2018 memberships, 12 of them new members. However, 71 members from 2017 have yet to renew. It was suggested that notes be sent to those 71 people encouraging them to continue their support for FOML.
2. Ellen is working on 2 membership drives
  - a. E-mailing businesses that have supported other nonprofits in the area. To date we have received 2 business memberships for a total of \$5,250.
  - b. Approach Measure S donors who are not yet Friends.

**MOTION: Pat moved that we pay the FOML 2017-18 current quarterly disbursement of \$1,000 to Modesto Library for previously approved budgeted items. Christine seconded it, and it passed unanimously.**

Maree passed out Modesto Library's FOML Request List 2018-19 for a total of \$10,000, including meeting dates when the funds were needed. It was approved at the March 7, 2018 meeting.

## OPERATIONS

### Used Book Sale: Pat Glatke

- Pat reported that over \$4,300 was raised and thanked everyone for their support. Special recognition goes to Cathie, and Marilyn and her husband, Tom, for all their work sorting. Michael Leamy assisted by selling more valuable books online.
- A **special thanks goes to McGrath Moving and Storage** who provided the moving van and helped load and unload the books, and to **Beard Land Development** who donated warehouse space with bookcases to aid in sorting. Some of the approximately 100 boxes of leftover books will be donated around town. It was suggested that next year we scan the bar codes to determine high-value books.
- Pat requested a volunteer for next year to help pickup books and schedule sorting parties.

### Scholastic Customer Appreciation Warehouse Sale: Anne Britton

Anne reported on the success of the 2018 Scholastic discount sale, the 13th year FOML has hosted. In addition to the hosting payment of \$1,000, FOML received 182 books for library programs worth close to \$2000.

### Dia de los Niños/Libros: Anne Britton

The 580 participants enjoyed this very successful event and over 428 new children's books were given out.

**Future Fundraising: Maree Hawkins**

Denise excused herself to attend a meeting with Diane McDonnell and David Dolan, who is proposing a music event in the street between the library and the Methodist church. This would provide an opportunity to get the word out about Friends to a different population.

**EVENTS/ACTIVITIES****Imagination Library: Cathie Peck**

Cathie was happy to report that at Burbank's kindergarten registration 20 new children signed up for the Imagination Library program at Burbank Elementary School. Christine suggested that FOML look into giving more financial support to the Imagination Library as we have in the past.

**Upcoming events**

- The Modesto Sound Audio Roots project will be presented at the Modesto Library on June 23rd from 2-4. The organization recorded oral histories of residents in the Modesto region, and they will be shared at this time.
- Stanislaus Library Foundation Authors Garden Gala will be September 22, 2018.
- Anne inquired about a calendar of events for the coming year. Denise will send one out.
- Anne suggested that a volunteer party with ice cream sundaes would be fun.

**Annual Meeting review**

It was agreed there was a good turnout and everything went well.
