Xia had a request for \$500 as a starting fund for the Community Garden program in partnership with the Garden Club. The money will be used to buy mulch, planks, plants, etc. There was discussion about who would be responsible for the garden and Xia said Garden Club volunteers will be taking care of it. Xia said the library will write an MOU as to the responsibilities of the Library and the Garden Club. Judy Jacob suggested planting succulents and Barbara Hartsell said the Garden Club plans to put in native plants. Barbara made a motion to give the library \$500 as a starting fund for the Community Garden. Trudy deGroot seconded, and the motion passed.
