The series is offered via Zoom and Stanislaus Library participants will have the opportunity to submit questions for the author when they register for the events.

First in the line-up is best-selling author, Alka Joshi, whose books have also been featured as Reese Witherspoon Book Club picks. She discusses her books, "The Henna Artist" and "The Secret Keeper of Jaipur" on Thursday, July 7 at 6 p.m.

During the interview, Alka will share her inspirations for her work, how her mother's life story has influenced her writing, and what it's been like working on creating a Netflix series based on her books.

He has earned worldwide and Forbes' recognition as one of the top five executive coaches in the United States.
