Community members can enjoy a number of free programs at the Turlock Library this July, beginning with the Turlock Teens Talk Books program on Saturday, July 1 at 3 p.m. This program provides teens with the opportunity to discuss their favorite books and find new book recommendations.

Children and their families can enjoy the "Didgeridoo Down Under" show on Wednesday, July 5 at 3 p.m. This Australia-themed show combines music, art, puppetry, comedy and science to promote tolerance and respect for all people and cultures. Children will learn about the wonders of the land "Down Under!" This program is best for ages four and up, however all ages are welcome to enjoy this interactive and educational show.

All ages are invited to take the Building Challenge on Tuesday, July 11 at 4 p.m. Participants can build their own unique creations using a variety of materials, including Keva planks, Magna Tiles, and cardboard.
