Link+ is a free service that allows you to request books and media from participating academic and public libraries throughout California and Nevada. If you have any questions, or want a reading recommendation, the Turlock Library staff are more than happy to help you find your next favorite book this reading season.

The next time you stop by the library, pick up a Stanislaus County Library's monthly calendar of events. We are offering some amazing programs. We have arts and craft programs for a variety of ages. Local Turlock teen and Stanislaus County Youth Poet Laureate, Faith Delgado will be leading a series of poetry events at the Turlock Library. The first program of the series was held on October 28th. Faith led a workshop for teens on spoken word poetry and performance. Her next teen poetry event will be on Saturday, December 16th at 1:30 pm. Faith and some of her fellow students will "speak their silence" by reading their own original pieces that pertain to school violence. This is an amazing partnership with a very talented teen.
